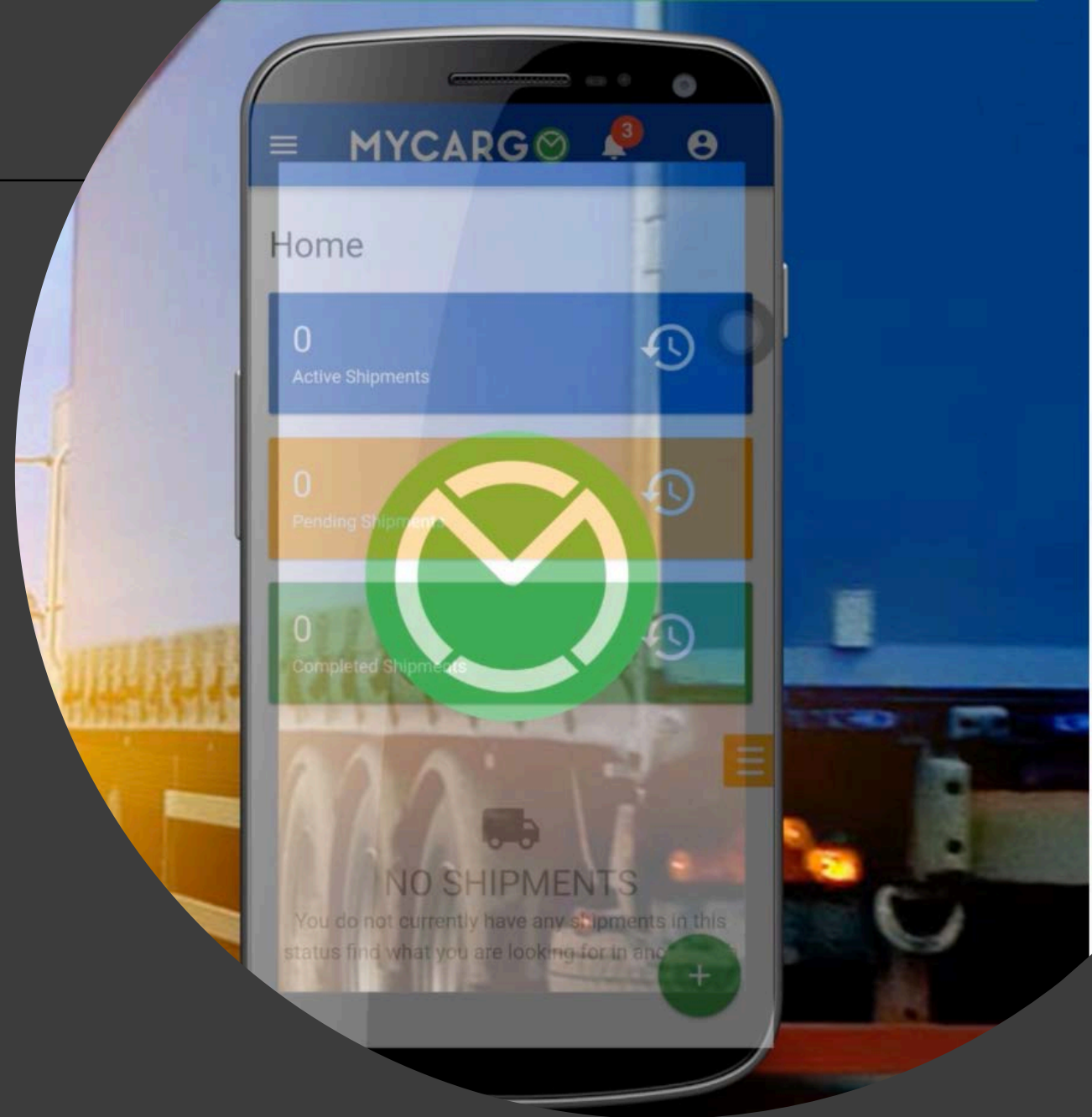


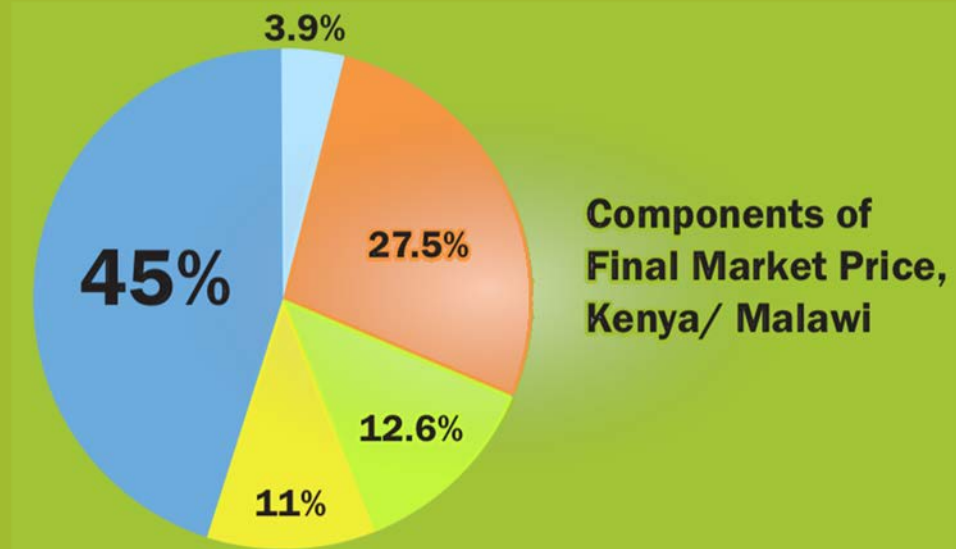

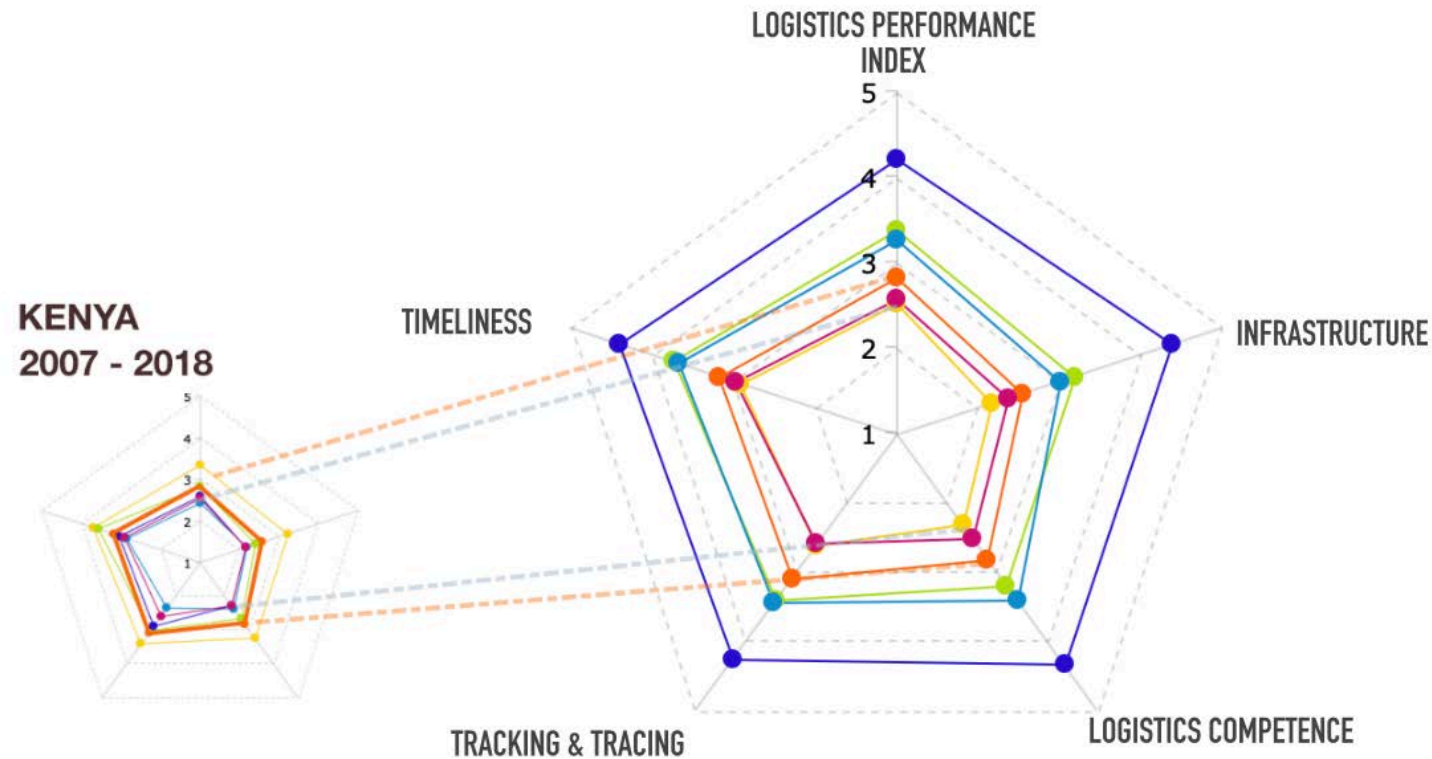
LOGISTICS IN EAC: HOW WE RANK

Transport costs account for around **30%** of average market prices in Kenya, twice the amount in comparable Asian countries

SHIPPING/FREIGHTING

Organisations that provide shipping or freighting of goods in bulk by trucks, trains, ships or aircrafts.



FREIGHT FORWARDING OR MANAGEMENT

Organisations that that organise shipments for individuals or companies from production to the end-user, or offer management solutions and networks for the supply chain.



COURIER SERVICES & LAST MILE DELIVERY

Organisations that offer on-demand delivery and transport of commercial goods and food products, or delivery to the final mile.



STORAGE & WAREHOUSING

Organisations that offer storage facilities where raw materials or manufactured goods can be stored prior to further distribution or collection.



COLD CHAIN

Organisations that offer temperature-controlled transport or storage of perishable goods.

Organisations that facilitate, deliver or manage post related services.

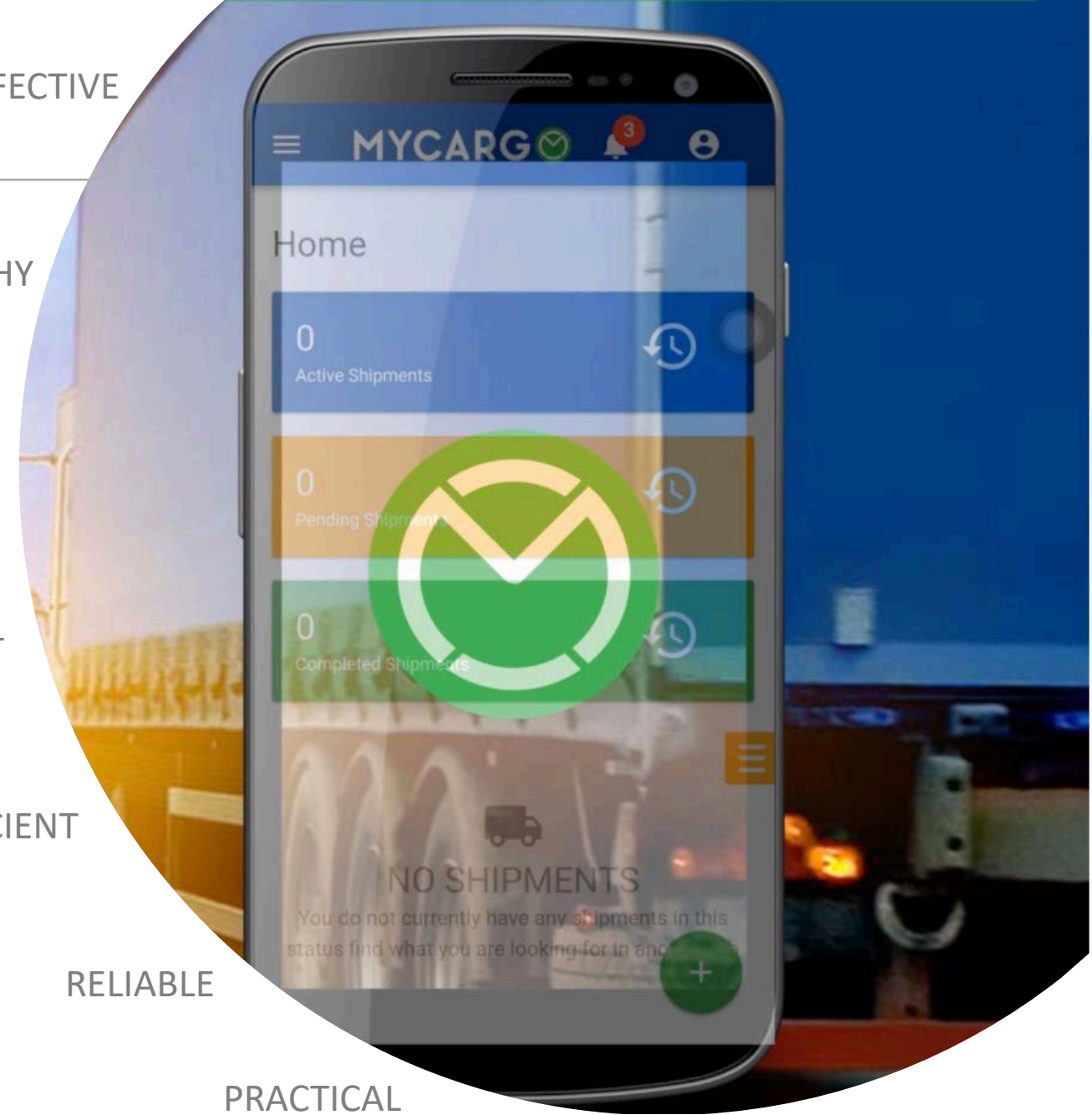

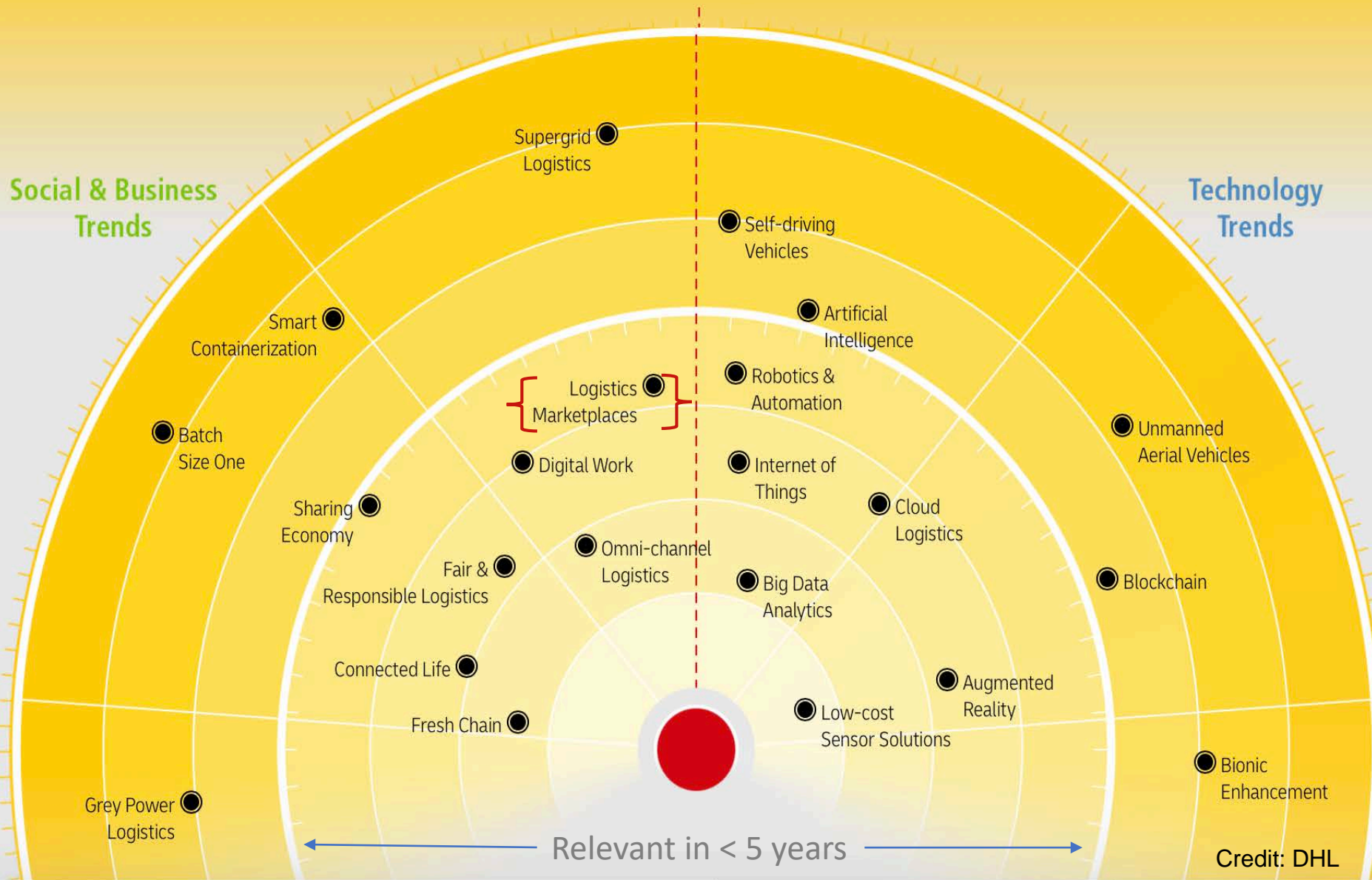

Transporters can accept offers or post bids to counter those of their competitors.

The most viable offer or bid is accepted by the requestor.

It has been observed that shipment owners can save up to 60% in transportation costs.

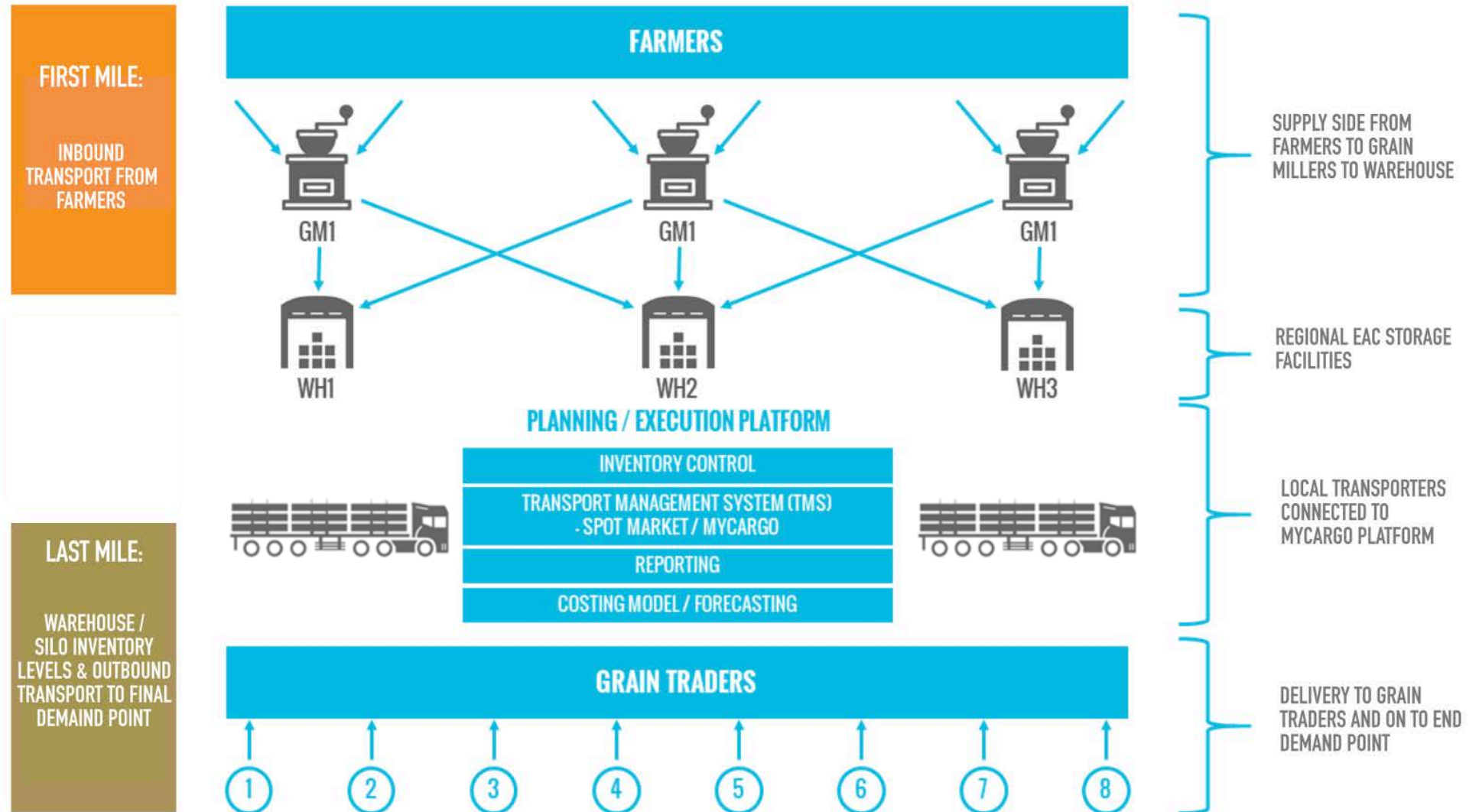
Win-win for all participants



Fewer trucks run empty. Transporters get extra cash, reduce waste and provide improved service at lower cost

GRAIN LOGISTICS

- Efficient Grains Logistics is a key element in achieving sustainable food security in the Africa, and thus a driver of competitiveness and economic development



ROADBLOCKS TO OVERCOME

- Address non-tariff barriers - simplify and harmonize compliance procedures and establish “single source of truth” Kenya – Ethiopia examples:
 - Reduce processing times at the border
 - Need to harmonize axle limits and other vehicle and operator regulations to allow for regional hauling
 - Equip One Stop Border Point facilities with adequate infrastructure (such as weigh bridges, laboratories and warehouses) for fewer delays and quicker turnaround
- Need for continent-wide accepted trading hubs that also cater for the less developed economies which may be ill-equipped to enable trade flows
- Address corruption and self-serving interests – partially through automation, instituting performance SLAs and allowing for easy access to regulatory information (with timely updates)
- Establishing a common trading currency and embracing innovations such as blockchain

OPPORTUNITIES UNDER AFCFTA

- New and expanded markets for digital logistics marketplaces
- Improved connectivity of Africa's rural communities beyond national to regional supply chains
- Expanded regional scope and hauling opportunities for transport partners
- Easier and often cheaper access to resources under the expanded market

Through organizations like East Africa Grain Council and their G-Soko platform, we aim to make logistics one less headache for grain farmers, millers and traders who need to trade move their product in a safe predictable, efficient and cost-effective manner across Africa.
